

# 【SINGAPORE】 CHANGES TO APPLICABLE SAFETY STANDARDS FOR MEDIUM-RISK CONTROLLED GOODS

CPSO (Consumer Product Safety Office) released new circular ([CPSO-310522-05](#)) on 2022/5/31 to update the changes to the required safety standards for medium risk Controlled Goods, regulated under the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Regulations (CPSR).

## The implement dates for the updated standard:

- for new registrations of Controlled Goods: [2024/6/1](#)
- for existing CoC certificate: [2025/6/1 \(1-year transition period\)](#) · certificates will no longer be accepted for renewal with old standard after the transition period .

For example:

The IEC62368-1:2014 certificate of GST220A will be valid until 2025/2/2, and the original standard can be used for renewal before 2025/6/1; but for the next renewal on 2028, new test reports based on the new standard (IEC 62368-1:2018) will be required for renewal.
